To help you register, please follow the directions carefully.

- Go to the **First United Interplanetary Bank** (See Back Page) as indicated on your map. There you may exchange your dollars for Shuttle Bucks to use anywhere in our facilities. Shuttle Bucks are similar to Traveler's Checks to use during your stay, and they can be replaced if lost or stolen. If you do not want to exchange your cash for Shuttle Bucks, you must sign a waiver at the bank.

- Go to the appropriate **Registration Table** as located on your map. The registration clerks will check you in and give you a package containing your name tag and your room information. Staff initials _____

- Go to the **Linen Closet**, as located on your map. There you will be issued linens for your use during your stay with us. You are responsible for the linens and will be billed if they are lost. Staff initials _____

- If you have pre-ordered or wish to purchase a flight suit or summer uniform, please go to the **Flight Deck** for your selection.

- If you have brought any type of medication, prescription or non-prescription, please take the medication to the **Sick Bay** as located on your map. A nurse is on duty 24 hours a day.

- If you are housed in Habitat I, please go up the stairwells or the elevator to your room. If you are being housed in Habitat II, follow the signs and counselors will be in the hall to escort you to the appropriate bay. If you did not bring a lock, the **Flight Deck** and **Duty Office** have locks available for sale. Your parents are welcome to help you unpack, make your bed, and visit with you.

- **Space Camp** – when you are ready to leave your room, please go directly to the **Team Room**, located on the **A DECK** of

Habitat II. Early activities and supervision will be provided. **Space Academy** when you are ready to leave your room, please go directly to the **Level I tour table** to sign up for a tour.

- For all programs, Orientation will take place at 2:00 PM. You will then form into teams, meet your team mates and counselor. Space Camp is to meet in the Team Room, and Space Academy is to meet at the Space Academy table located in Habitat I. 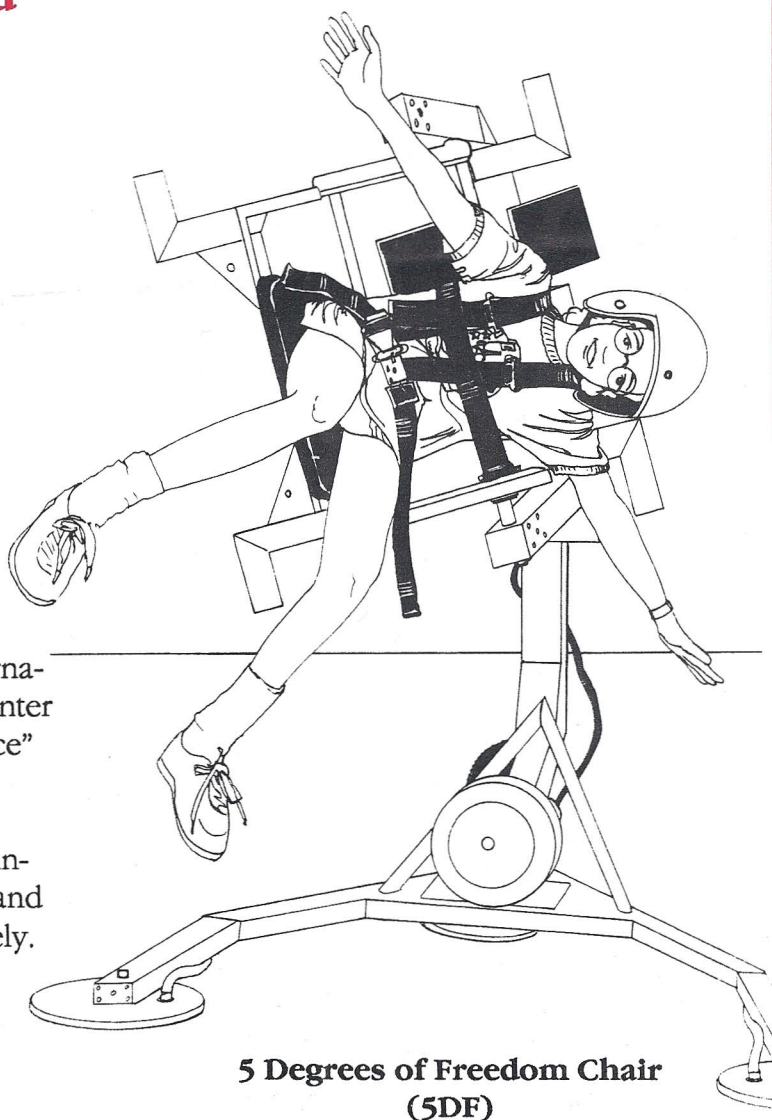
Due to the short time span that your child is here, please mail only essential items.

Today's Activities:

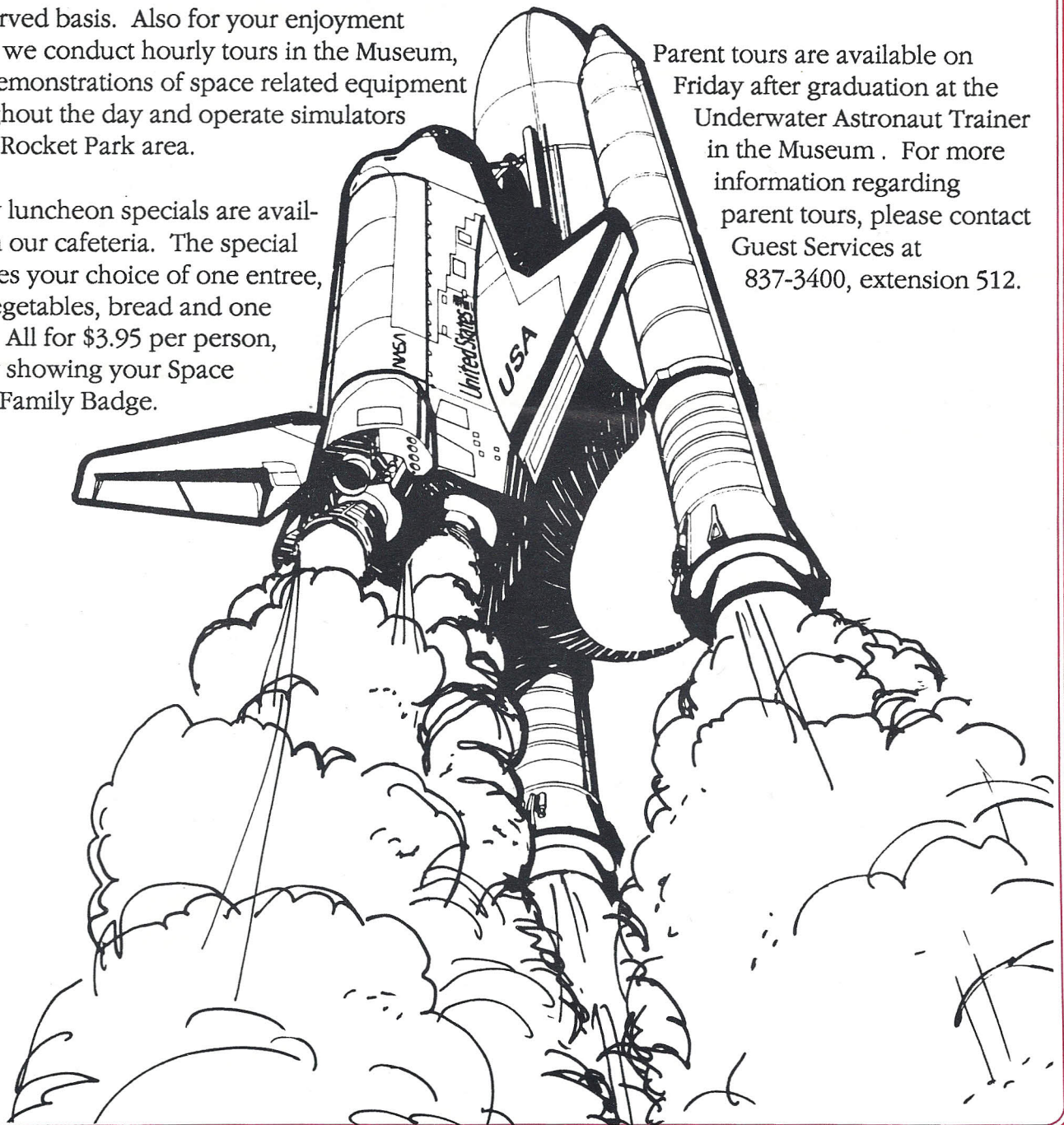

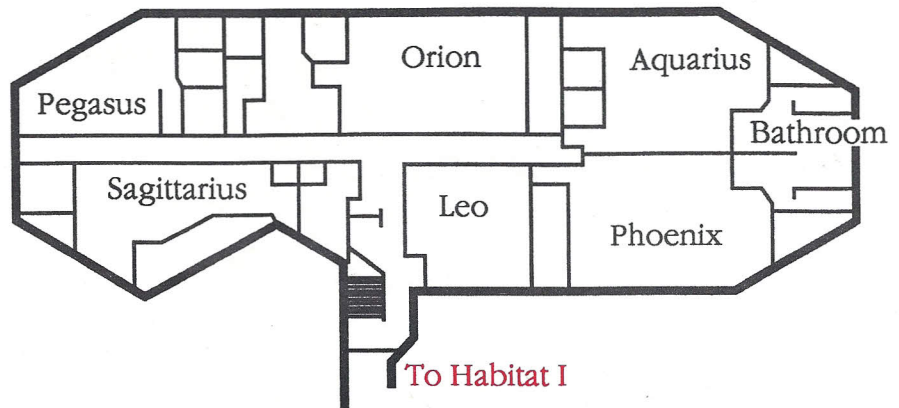
Parent's day and graduation:

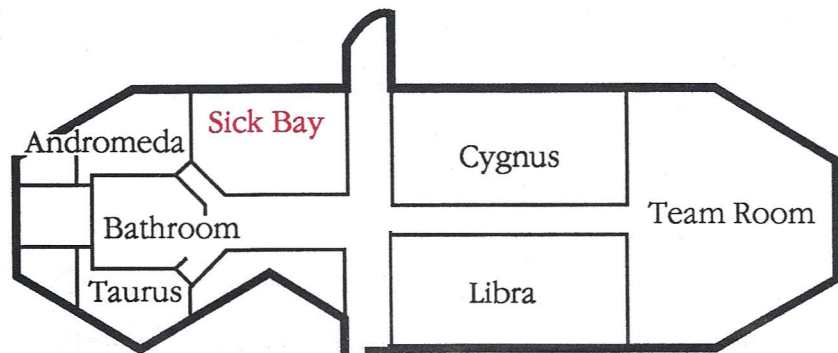
