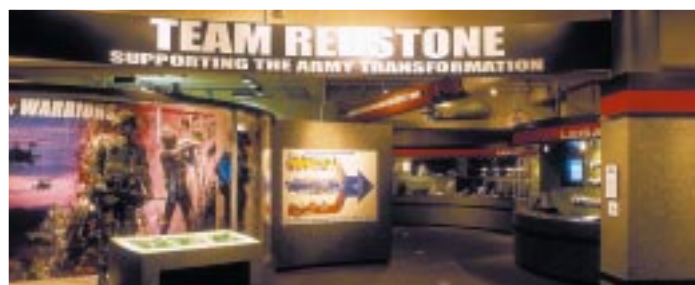

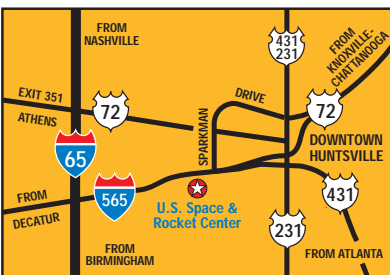
## OPERATING SCHEDULE

*There may be an additional charge for special IMAX® presentations.*

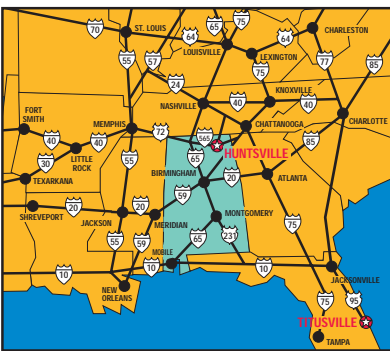

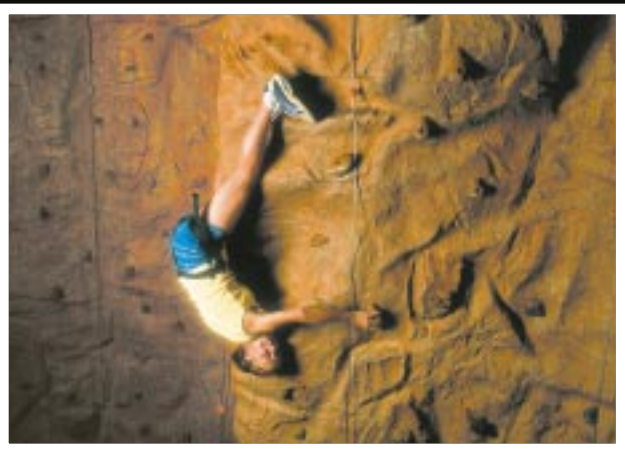

**G-Force Accelerator** — Experience three times the force of gravity as you spin like crazy in the G-Force Accelerator.

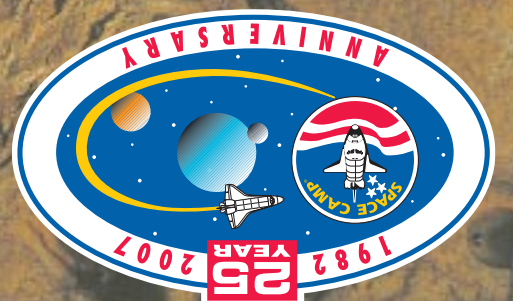


**Mars Mission** — A virtual journey across Martian terrain that just might surprise you!
