

#### MATERIALS

- 8 1/2" X 11" copy paper
- Scissors
- Glue

- Thumbtack
- Wooden dowel or straw




Only a grown-up should do any cutting.





- 1. Choose two of the patterns on the following pages and print them out. Cut out the patterns.
- 2. Glue the backsides of the two square pattern pieces to each other (designed side out).
- 3. Cut along the four gray dashed lines on each square pattern.
- Pull the right corner from each spoke towards the black dot in the center, making sure not to crease the fold. Secure all four spokes by pressing a thumbtack through each spoke and to the black center dot.
- 5. Stick the thumbtack into your stick of choice (wooden dowel or straw), which will serve as your pinwheel's handle.
